Dear Reverend Pastors,

I am writing you on behalf of Fr. Louis Baudon de Mony and with the permission of Fr. Berg, who strongly encourages the following request, as well as the District Superior Fr. Flood. I hope that this Email finds you all well and ready for the Christmas season which is fast upon us.

You may be aware that the primary occupation of our pastoral work here in Colombia is centered on running our own school Santo Domingo Savio. Our goal is to provide the less fortunate with an excellent education but most importantly to provide our young 100 plus students with orthodox Catholic teachings and the traditional liturgy so that they might grow into fervent Catholics and continue to practice their faith long after leaving our school.

We have begun building a new two story building to replace the open air temporary structures which were built three years ago. The new building will be better suited to accommodate our growing numbers and will be a great help to the teachers who often have to battle wind, rain, and noise while teaching in the current open air classrooms.

In order to complete this project, we are in need of around \$100,000. We would be most grateful if you could mention our needs before your Sunday sermon and then take up a **second collection during the lenten season** to help us raise these funds and offer a better environment for our students and teachers.
