PILGRIMAGE HIGHLIGHTS

- ❖ Accommodation in Rome 1 km from St. Peter's Square
- ❖ Daily Mass in the Extraordinary Form
- ❖ Sunday Angelus and Apostolic Blessing
- ❖ Visits to St. Peter's, the Vatican Necropolis, the Vatican Gardens, the Vatican Museums and Sistine Chapel, St. Paul Outside-the-Walls, St. John Lateran, the Scala Sancta, St. Mary Major
- ❖ Visit and Mass at FSSP parish SS. Trinita dei Pellegrini
- ❖ Tour of St. Clement Basilica, the Catacombs, ancient Roman sites
- ❖ Two days in the town of Assisi



The cost of the pilgrimage is **\$3,300 per person*** and includes:

- ❖ Return overseas flight Ottawa to Rome (via Montreal), departing late afternoon July 22nd and returning August 2nd
- ❖ 8 nights' accommodation in Rome
- ❖ Travel between Rome and Assisi
- ❖ Breakfast and evening meal each day
- ❖ Tour escort
- ❖ Entrance fees and guided tours

The cost does not include:

- transportation to and from airport in Canada
- travel and health insurance
- lunches
- alcoholic beverages
- tips

*additional fees apply for pilgrims wishing to have a single room



Registration form, copy of passport, and non-refundable deposit of **\$500** is due on or before Palm Sunday, **March 25**, 2018.

The **balance** of payment is due Tuesday, **May 1**, 2018.

Italy requires visitors to possess a passport valid for six months beyond the length of stay, which means the passport of pilgrims for Rome 2018 should not expire before February 2019. Registering pilgrims without a current passport are asked to start the process of acquiring one without delay.
